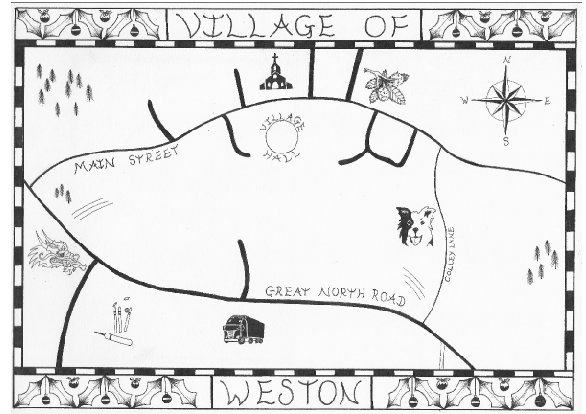

Weston Broadband—Community needed!

Openreach have now given a firm quotation to install Fibre to the premises (FTTC) to 146 premises in Weston.

There has been a lot of work to get to the point and we are now at the stage where we need the community to come together and register their interest in the scheme. We need to get enough households or businesses signed up to meet the total cost of almost £180,000. If we can achieve this, then the only commitment is to sign up to a service which doubles your internet speed within 12 months of the scheme being installed. It would also be good if any villagers wanting a better service, were able to offer some time to help with the next stage.
