Bus Service 37 Information

Nottinghamshire County Council intends to step in to save bus services which operators have decided are no longer profitable. These services would otherwise have been reduced or withdrawn by operators for commercial reasons, but will now continue in their current form: Marshalls 37 - Retford, East Markham, Tuxford, Sutton on Trent, Muskham, Newark (service would otherwise be withdrawn).

The County Council's financial support for these services as part of its Bus Network Review is being agreed with the commercial operators and for the time being, passengers won't see any difference in route or timetables, although the services may be subject to redesign and review over the next 12 months. Please use this service, this vital transport link could be lost.

Types of Path in the Parish of Weston

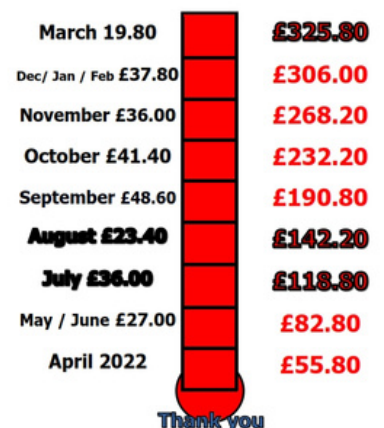
The Parish Council has received complaints that horse riders are using public footpaths in Weston causing the surfaces to be difficult for pedestrians to navigate. In particular

- Footpath 2 -
Leading from Main street to the rear of All Saints church
- Footpath 4 -
Leading from Meadow Lane near its junction with Colley Lane & Main Street.
- Footpath 6 -
Leading from the Eastern End of Meadow Lane

These Footpaths are for pedestrians only.
Horses should only be ridden on designated bridleways and not footpaths
